Component 01 - portfolio which is worth 60% of total GCSE. Theme is Close-ups project.

AO1 - looking at the work of relevant artists.

AO2 - refine work by exploring ideas and experimenting with materials and techniques.

AO3 - record ideas and observations. Drawings, sketches, and photographs.

AO4 - final outcome. Present a personal and meaningful response, make connections between your work and contextual sources.

Component 02 - externally set-task which is worth 40% of total GCSE
